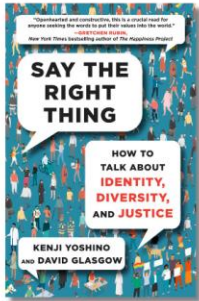

[Kenji Yoshino](#) is the Chief Justice Earl Warren Professor of Constitutional Law at NYU School of Law and the Director of the Meltzer Center for Diversity, Inclusion and Belonging. A graduate of Harvard (AB *summa cum laude*), Oxford (MSc as a Rhodes Scholar) and Yale (JD), Kenji specializes in constitutional law, antidiscrimination law, and law and literature. He is a prolific writer whose work has been featured in academic and mainstream publications. His fourth book (co-authored with David Glasgow), [*Say the Right Thing: How to Talk About Identity, Diversity, and Justice*](#), was published in 2023. Kenji serves on multiple boards and has won numerous awards for his teaching and scholarship. He lives in Manhattan with his husband, two children, and a Great Dane.
